*Thinking in Public* consists of seven 'realities', each of which is explored collectively – silently and through debate – by those participating in the events.

The realities in question are poverty, fear, austerity, security, migration, identity and solidarity.

- :: The format/setting of *Thinking in Public* is that of a public lecture, with both in- and outdoor locations chosen to reflect the respective 'reality' of each event.
- :: There are seven events in total, one for each of the seven realities, each one consisting of a welcome address and introduction, a *Silent Lecture* and an open-ended debate.
- :: Each of these *Silent Lectures* is 20 minutes long and is delivered either by Nicodemus himself or, if a member of the audience offers to volunteer, by that person.
- :: All *Seven Silent Lectures* and debates are recorded by the audience using their phones. Utilising this material, a film will be produced and published at [www.unruhe.eu](http://www.unruhe.eu).
