The foci in question are poverty, fear, austerity, security, migration, identity and solidarity.

- :: The format/setting of **Thinking in Public** is that of a site-specific performance lecture series, where the locations selected for the series reflect the foci of the respective lectures.
- :: The series is made up of seven events (one for each focus), with each event consisting of a short introduction, a *Silent Lecture* and a discussion.
- :: Each of these *Silent Lectures* is 20 minutes long and is delivered either by Nicodemus or, if a member of the audience offers to volunteer, by that person.
